SECTION 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 92-006 series of 1992, entitled "An Ordinance Imposing An Amusement Tax On Amusement Places In The City Of Zamboanga And Providing Penalty For Violation Thereof" is hereby amended, to read as follows:

"SECTION 5. - EXEMPTION.

Likewise, all boxing promotions, including Karate, Judo, and other sports activities, whether professional or amateur, shall be exempted from the payment of amusement tax, except professional basketball. This exemption shall be covered for a period of five (5) years from the approval of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2 .- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval. wxto
