----- Explanatory Note

In the past, boxing is one of the popular sports in the City of Zamboanga. The city has produced rated professional boxers local and international. But because of one reason or another, boxing had lost its popularity.

The reason why promoters are hesitant to promote boxing in the city is because of lack of support from the local government and private organizations and, most especially, the payment of amusement tax, which puts the promoter into a losing venture.

It is noteworthy to state that in the City of Mandaluyong, boxing became so popular as can be gleaned from television because of the full support of the local government.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Zamboanga,

SECTION 1.- Section 5 of Ordinance No. 92-006 series of 1992, entitled "An Ordinance Imposing An Amusement Tax On Amusement Places In The City Of Zamboanga And Providing Penalty For Violation Thereof" is hereby amended, to read as follows:

"SECTION 5. - EXEMPTION.

x x x x

Likewise, all boxing promotions, including Karate, Judo, and other sports activities, whether professional or amateur, shall be exempted from the payment of amusement tax, except professional basketball. This exemption shall be covered for a period of five (5) years from the approval of this Ordinance."

SECTION 2.- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
